February 11, 2026

The following are the minutes of the regular monthly meeting of the City of Norwood, Kentucky, held on Tuesday, February 11, 2026 via Zoom.

The following City Officers were present: Mayor Bill Burnham, Commissioners Anne Burnham, Dan Able, Rudy Vaca and Brian Driscoll. Also present at the meeting was City Attorney Carrie Ritsert and Treasurer Paul Medina.

Mayor Bill Burnham called the meeting to order at 7:32 P.M. City Clerk Ashley Redenbaugh reported the minutes.

Minutes for the January 2026 meeting were sent prior to tonight's meeting. Anne Burnham made a motion to dispense with the reading of and approve the minutes for January 2025. Brian Driscoll seconded the motion and a vote in favor was unanimous.
